About the Play:

All StarZ educates and entertains students in grades K-3. **All StarZ** follows three students at school. Kim rules the playground and has set up a "Club", putting herself in charge of picking the members. Jackie wants to fit in with the popular kids and quickly falls under Kim's influence. Michael just wants the girls to leave him alone so he can play boys sports and do things where there are "*no girls allowed*". Soon all three characters are caught up in social conflict which causes each of them to be mean to one another. Through the help of the principal, they all realize that telling people what to do, name calling and exclusion are not the way to make friends. Students observe real life bullying situations and observe positive role modeling when the characters learn how to respect one another.

Post Performance:

Following the performance there is an interactive discussion lead by the three actors/educators who help reinforce the educational points of the play. The actors will also facilitate a question and answer period and if time permits they may play some interactive games with the students.
